Our Science topic is Plants

In our Plants topic, we will observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants.

We will find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

In Maths this term we will be looking at: Calculations including formal written methods for + / - (crossing 10)

- Position, direction and motion
- Data handling
- Problem solving and reasoning
- Mental recall of the times tables and addition and subtraction facts
- Properties of shape and units of measure
- Telling the time - quarter to /quarter past
