In English we will be studying The Last Thing by Shaun Tan. During the topic, we will be exploring the story and using it as a tool to write a newspaper report and embed writing conventions from throughout the year.

In the Summer 2 term, we will be studying the classic novel of Peter Pan to write our own narratives.

We will be:

- Exploring how to use adventurous vocabulary for effect.*
- Using various forms of punctuation and a variety of grammar conventions.*
- Identifying how sentence structure can change meaning and emphasis.*
- Studying the composition of various text types to develop purpose and audience, as well as atmosphere and suspense.*
- Exploring poetic features which can build imagery.*

In Science, our topics will be: 'Electricity' and 'Sound'

- To construct a range of circuits and identify different conductors and insulators.*
- To explain how sounds are made and explore how pitch and volume can be altered.*

In Maths we will be

- Exploring properties of 2d and 3d shapes, including their angles and parallel lines.*
- Presenting and handling data.*
- Identifying the value of Roman Numerals*
- Solving multi step word problems using mathematical concepts we have previously studied.*
