In English this term we will be looking at:

- Fantasy Story writing (The Kiss That Missed)
- We will be following the letters and sounds programme for phonics. Each week the children will continue to be given words to practise. Great phonic games can be found on www.phonicsplay.co.uk.
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Our Science topic is Materials

We will:

- Distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made.
- Identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock.
- Describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials.

In Maths this term we will be looking at:

- Number and place value
- Addition and subtraction
- 3D shapes
- Measurement, length/height and weight/volume

You can help your child by helping them to apply the strategies taught to solve the questions in your homework packs.

Pupils will recognise and describe local human geographical features from around Baildon Primary School.

Pupils will explore maps of the local area, including the school, and understand how basic symbols are used to represent features

Pupils will learn to create a simple map of the school based on satellite photos.

Other work will be:

RE - Who is Jewish and how do they live? Re-tell simply some stories used in Jewish celebrations (e.g. Hanukkah or Sukkot) • Give examples of how Jewish people celebrate special times (e.g. Shabbat, Sukkot, Chanukah), Ask some questions about what Jewish people celebrate and why.
