In addition, school will gain commission from every book that is sold, in the form of FREE BOOKS! The more books we sell, the higher the commission (25-60%) and the more free books the school can choose for the library.

Over 200 books will be available to view and purchase in the school hall at 3.15pm - 4.00pm each day, from Tuesday 17th to Monday 23rd March. The fair will also be open during parent consultation evenings on Wednesday 18th and Thursday 19th March. Cash, cheque and card payments are welcome. £1 World Book Day Tokens and National Book Tokens will also be accepted.
