### **Shipley Area School Uniform Bank - Accepted Donations**

**Trousers + shorts** – Primary age – black, navy & grey.

**Skirts** – Primary age – black, navy & grey. Secondary age – black only.

**Dresses** – Primary age only – Pinafore dresses, and all local colours summer check designs.

**Polo t-shirts** – Primary age – all local colours, logo or plain. Secondary age – logo only.

**White shirts** – Primary + Secondary age.

**Uniform jumpers & cardigans** – Primary age – all local colours, logo or plain. Secondary age – logo only.

**Ties & Blazers** – all local schools .
