

Welcome to Year 2

We hope you are well and we are really looking forward to welcoming you back into school. As of Monday 8th June, school will begin for you at 8.50am and finish for you at 3.05pm. It will finish at 12.05am on Friday. You will need to enter and exit the school site via the main school gates pictured below



Year 2 children are to left at the KS1 gate and a staff member will watch them as they walk along path to 2D
Additional staff member will be at the corner by kitchen to ensure that they cross safely.

At the end of the day, the children will be walked back up to the side of the Jungle trail to be handed over to parents.

However, if the weather is wet, parents are asked to walk down towards the Main Office and we will dismiss the children once we see the parent.
