Dear Parent/Carers,

On Thursday and Friday the 22nd and 23rd of October, Year 6 are going to partake in two days of outdoor learning as part of their Recovery Curriculum Programme. This will include:

- Thursday: Den building, fire-pit booking and land art.
- Friday: a muddy fun hike around the local area.

We will be walking approximately three miles in total following footpaths through local fields and woods. The route has been risk assessed and trialled in advance (a map showing where we will be going can be provided should you wish). There will be several members of staff, including a trained first aider, attending whilst carrying a mobile phone and first aid kit in case of any emergencies.

We recommend that your child wears appropriate outdoor clothes for these two days that you do not mind getting dirty and wet that also cover their legs, in order to avoid nettle stings and scratches. They also need to wear outdoor running shoes, wellies or walking boots as the children will be walking across very muddy terrain, including crossing a stream.
