Reading: From 8th March we are excited to be able to send reading books home with your child. As your child may be heard reading on any day, please ensure they bring their book bag to school each day. We welcome any comments and queries in the purple diary and you will also be able to see which day your child has been read to by a member of the Early Years team.



Prime Areas: There will be a big focus on the children's mental health and their return to school. On Monday 8th March, we will be off timetable to allow the children to reconnect with each other and engage in fun activities.



RE: In RE, we are learning about Easter and Holy Week through the story, The Hungry Caterpillar. We will enjoy looking after caterpillars and watching them develop into beautiful butterflies.

English: In English we are exploring 'Untraditional Tales,' thinking about the Wolf in the Three Little Pigs and if he really was guilty. We will also read the Gingerbread Man and think about alternative story endings.



Maths: In Mathematics, the children will apply their knowledge of number to larger numbers. We will continue to subitise and conserve numbers up to 10 and further develop their knowledge of number bonds, addition and subtraction. We will continue to explore money and 3D shapes.

Understanding the World: Linked to our English focus, we will design and make bridges that will hopefully allow the Gingerbread Man to escape the hungry fox and run safely across the river.

Expressive Arts and Design: We will create observational drawings of spring flowers and enjoy Easter crafts.
