
I would like to share with you a variety of useful maths resources that can be used to engage your child with maths whilst developing their knowledge in an enjoyable manner.

One Minute Maths

This provides a fun and quick-fire opportunity to boost confidence, accuracy and understanding. It is available as a website and can be downloaded as an app.

Key Stage One

Numbots

NumBots is all about every child achieving the "triple win" of understanding, recall and fluency in mental addition and subtraction, so that they move from counting to calculating. Pupils create their own avatar and the tasks become increasingly challenging as they progress and earn points. All pupils have been given their unique login codes and can access it either using the website, or as an app.

This can be played online or downloaded as an app and is a fantastic resource for developing recall of timetable facts- a skill that lies at the heart of mathematics.




All ages
