### **Disco on 10.11.22**

### **Winter Fair**

Mostly positive feedback received. Wi-Fi issue was the main complaint. Refunds of stall fee offered to stall holders which only one stall holder requested. Big queue for Santa. Need to work a better system for this in future. Raised £1983.

### **Santa's Secret Room**

Liza, Jane & Kelly did a fantastic job. Access to the PTFA debit card made purchasing presents easier. Gemma transferred money quickly if presents were purchased by volunteers' own money. Cutting wrapping paper in advance, having a team responsible for wrapping presents and Yr 6 pupils taking younger children back to their classrooms all made it more efficient.

Suggestion to buy presents earlier in the year. Storage is an issue. Approx 1200 gifts purchased. Plenty of volunteers. If we get volunteers again then we will ask them to cut some wrapping paper in advance. Even though expenditure on SS presents was higher this year, still raised £1902.

### **Bag2School**

Booked collection for Monday 6<sup>th</sup> February. Need to promote again. Agreed on a midweek text message and one on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> February.

Raised £265 last year. We will benefit from an increased price per kilo as have booked it twice this year.

### **Amazon Smile**

### **World Book Day**

School covering this, PTFA involvement not required.

### **Year 6**

Gemma & Liza have consulted with Yr 6 parents. They would like photo books. PTFA have previously donated £300 - £400 to Yr 6. PTFA are concerned about photo books. Approximately £5 per book (from Hobbycraft) and time consuming to personalise. May be more photos and content for some children than for others. Preference would be for photo booth at the leavers party at school as more inclusive. PTFA would like to ask the kids to vote about what they want. Suggestion for an autograph book. Only one child didn't turn up for the Leavers' Party last year.

AGM in September 2023 needs to announce any changes to this formally.

### **Disco**

Proposal to organise another disco. KS suggested Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> May.

Agreed we would need to group the discos differently (Nursery & Rec, Yrs 1 – 3, Yrs 4-6). Same timings as last one. Refreshments could be served outside.

Better traffic management would be required. We could contact PCSOs to help with traffic and also encourage people to walk.

### **Baildon Carnival**

Dated confirmed as 8<sup>th</sup> July. Discussion about our involvement needed at future meeting.

### **School Summer Fair**

Date confirmed as 21<sup>st</sup> July. Discussion needed at future meeting.

### **Happy Circus**

Jointly organising with Sandal PTFA. Plan is to sell tickets in both schools from early March. Can sell remaining tickets at Baildon Carnival. 1200 tickets across the weekend, 600 per day.

Will sell via Happy Circus website. Need to have some control so tickets are shared equally across both schools.

Price recommendation for £36 per family of 4.

Idea suggested to register interest in advance to establish idea of numbers and random selection as to who gets tickets.

Happy Circus owner is currently ill so some events have been cancelled.

### **My School Lottery**

Proposal to set up this scheme. Lottery ticket - £1 a week.

Winners would be from our school.

**ACTION: WL to look in to whether this is viable.**

### **Penalty Shoot Out**

Proposal for sponsored event run by BCFC who would take 50% of profit. Agreed that is a lot for BCFC to take and could raise more funds elsewhere.

**BBQ**

Chef Nathan would like a new BBQ as existing one was damaged at the Summer Fair and has been condemned. £900 quote for a new BBQ.

**ACTION: KS to speak to Phil Hiley to investigate how the damaged was caused plus storage options.  
EJ & WL to look into BBQs and cash flow to pay for this.**

**Fundraising**

KS confirmed she would like future funds raised to go towards sound and lighting for the school hall.
